



DE-WINTERIZING YOUR RV CHECKLIST



RV season is here! After a long winter in storage, it's time to get your RV or travel trailer back ready for the road again.

Our simple checklist will help you quickly run through all the necessary steps to de-winterize your RV so that you can start planning a season of fun on and off the road. Get started:

INSPECTION



EXTERIOR INSPECTION

- Check the body and roof for signs of cracks or separation along any seams.
- Check for peeling paint or rust, especially in problem-prone areas like wheel wells, doors, or windows.
- Check your tires for damage, low pressure, or loose lug nuts.
- Look under the vehicle for puddles or other signs of leaking fluids.
- If applicable, check the hitch and hitch components.



INTERIOR INSPECTION

- Do a walkthrough to look for any interior signs of leaks, damage, or invasive critters.
- Check your appliances and clean them of any dust or dirt.



BATTERIES & POWER



BATTERIES & POWER

- Ensure shore power is disconnected and main power is switched off before beginning battery inspections.
- Inspect batteries and battery connections for signs of damage or corrosion.
- Test your battery and top off fluids if necessary.
- Carefully reinstall the battery, paying special mind to install it correctly.

SYSTEMS



WATER SYSTEM

- Flush your water system by filling the fresh water tank with water, then turn on the water pump.

WARNING: Never run your water pump or water heater when they are empty.

- Shut your water pump off and more water through the system to ensure it is flushed.
- Sanitize your plumbing using RV water cleaner or a mixture of 1 cup bleach & 1 gallon of water.



GAS SYSTEMS

- Open the gas valve that was closed for proper storage.
- Test any gas appliances.

NOTE: This may take multiple attempts for each appliance.



ENGINE

- If motorized, check the fluid levels



ENGINE CONT...

- Inspect under the hood and under your RV for damage or evidence of animals/insects
- Start the engine to ensure it operates correctly.
- Test all headlights, brake lights, turn signals or other lights.
